Dear Parents and Carers,

I hope you had an enjoyable and relaxing break over the holidays. We have an exciting term ahead and I am really looking forward to all of the fun learning that we have to come. The children have made a fantastic start to the term and it has been great to have them all back in the classroom.

Our Learning:

Literacy:

In Literacy, we will be learning about different Fairy Tales, including Cinderella and Rapunzel. We will learn about the characters and then write our own short narratives based on the stories. We will continue to focus on verbal rehearsal of our stories and using finger spaces, capital letters and full stops when sentence writing independently.

Maths:

This term we will be revisiting Place Value with a focus on teen numbers and ordering numbers to 20. We will be learning addition and subtraction facts within 20 including doubles and number bonds.

RE: In Religious Education we will be learning about Judaism and what it is like to live as a Jewish person. In the Summer term, we will be looking at Islam.

Science: Our Science topic this term is 'Treasure Island' we are going to learn how we can survive on our island and learn about the animals that live there and how we can group them.

Geography: We will be learning about the differences between the Sahara and Antarctic deserts, and what kind of animals and plants can we find in these places.

Art: We will be developing control when using a wide range of tools to draw, paint and create crafts and sculptures.

PE: We will be exploring gym sequences through gymnastics. We will be working with Chelsea FC for our fitness sessions with a focus on core strength.

PSHE: This term in PSHE we will be learning about online safety and about how feelings can be hurt by things that are said online.

Music: We will be learning about rhythm and beat in our music lessons through songs and dances.

Computing: In computing we will be creating animated stories on Purple Mash and then we will be creating mazes, realising the importance of the arrow keys and following instructions carefully.
