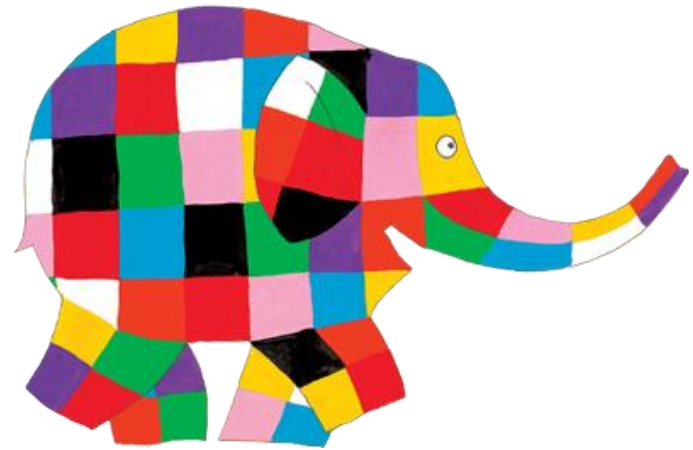
The weather continues to be cold and unpredictable at the minute, so please ensure your child has a coat with them everyday to allow them to enjoy our outdoor spaces.

Dear Parents and Carers,

I hope you had a relaxing and restful half term break. We have had a fantastic start to the term in Class 1 and we are excited about what is coming up.

Our P.E days will remain on Monday and Wednesday this term. We are proud of the progress that children are making when getting changed for P.E. Please make sure all uniform and P.E kit is clearly named.

Our Learning:

Literacy:

In Literacy, we will be writing narratives. We will be looking at the classic stories Elmer and The Tiger Who Came to Tea and producing writing based on them. We will also use the story Handa's Surprise to write a fact file on fruit.

Maths:

This term we will be learning about how many tens and ones are in numbers to 50. We will also be learning about length and height and mass and volume.

Science: Our Science topic this term is 'Celebrations' we will be learning about light and shadow, making our own instruments and learning more about our senses.

RE: In Religious Education we will be learning about Christianity, focussing on the Ten Commandments and then the Easter story.

Geography: In Geography we will be drawing aerial maps of the classroom, school and local area. We will be learning about the basic human and physical features of our local environment.

Design Technology: We will be learning textiles skills such as joining fabrics using pins to design and create a puppet.

PSHE: We will be learning about what it means to be healthy and what we can do to promote good health. We will be discussing exercise, dental hygiene, screen time and having a good sleep routine.

PE: We will be continuing with our fitness sessions this term and we will be doing ball skills.

Computing: We will be learning to code, we will learn about algorithms and follow simple sets of instructions to debug and create simple programs.

Music: We will be learning new songs with Miss Clover and learning about pulse and rhythm and playing a range of instruments.
