Ensure your child has excellent attendance and that they arrive at school on time.


As always, do not hesitate to contact me if you have any concerns. I am available in the playground from 8.55am or after school once I have dismissed the students.

Dear Parents and Carers,

I hope you and your child have had a lovely, relaxing break.

Literacy: In Literacy, we will be studying Stig of the Dump by Clive King. We will first focus on writing to inform in the form of a non-chronological report. We will then move onto writing to entertain by retelling the narrative.

Maths: In maths we will begin with multiplication and division before moving onto length and perimeter.

Science: Our topic this term is 'Opposites attract', which will focus on magnetic forces. We will complete lots of hands-on investigations to aid our learning.

RE: In religious education we will move from Christianity to Judaism and think about what it means to be Jewish. We will continue to ask big questions and challenge ourselves to uncover links between religions.

History: We will begin to learn about prehistory, looking at the Stone Age. Particular attention will be given to the Mesolithic and Neolithic periods, investigating how people lived during this time.

Art: In Art, our unit is called 'Growing Artists' and will support our understanding of shading, texture and composition.

Music: This half term Class 3 will be continue to participate in musicianship with PMF (Pimlico Music Foundation).

PSHE: PSHE will be varied, but will largely focus on feelings and mental health. Students will also learn about the emergency services and what to do in an emergency.

PE: PE will take place on Wednesday mornings with support from Chelsea FC in the school grounds. Please ensure your child brings their PE kit to change into each week. Class 3 will continue swimming lessons every Monday afternoon starting on Monday 13th January.

Spanish: We will learn about musical instruments as well as beginning to create short phrases.

Computing: Computing will comprise of learning about spreadsheets and touch typing.
