

## Class 3 Newsletter



Autumn Term 2024

Dear Parents and Carers,
I hope you have had a restful and revitalising summer. I am
so delighted to welcome your child to Class 3 and am
looking forward to what should be a really fun and exciting
term.

Literacy: We will focus on writing to entertain, basing our work on 'Paddington' by Michael Bond. This will include character and setting descriptions as well as producing diary entries.

Maths: In maths we will be continuing to develop our understanding of place value - partitioning, estimating and comparing numbers. We will also be building on our addition and subtraction knowledge, spotting patterns and making connections.

Science: Our science topic this term is 'Mirror, mirror' which will focus on light. We will have a particular emphasis on working scientifically and will plan different types of enquiries to answer questions.

RE: In religious education we will be learning about Christianity and the big story of the bible. We will begin to ask big questions and think about how we can relate our learning to our own lives.

History: We will be delving into ancient Egypt, studying how people lived during this ancient civilisation and paying particular attention to their beliefs. We will also look at interesting artefacts and tombs/pyramids.

Art: We will be designing and creating our own Ancient Egyptian scrolls.

Music: This half term Class 3 will be participating in musicianship with PMF (Pimlico Music Foundation) every Tuesday.

PE: PE will take place on Tuesday afternoons. We will be developing a variety of skills, including balance, coordination and agility. Students will change into their PE kit in school so please do ensure they bring the appropriate gear each week (black fleeces and trainers- no hoodies please). We will also attend swimming lessons every Monday afternoon. A swimming letter has been sent home with further information.

Spanish: Spanish will be very exciting as we will be introduced to the phonetics of the Spanish language.

PSHE: PSHE will focus on what a healthy lifestyle is and how to have healthy relationships with others.

Computing: Computing will build on coding ability as well as reinforcing the importance of online safety.

Homework: Students are expected to read nightly. They should also practise their times tables on Times Tables Rock Stars, focussing on the 2, 3, 4, 5, 8 and 10s. We also commence Genius homework this year - please see me if you have any questions regarding this.
