## How can I support my child?


- Class 3 have continued to make progress in their reading so please do continue to listen to your child read every day.

## Class 3 Newsletter

Dear Parents and Carers,
I hope both you and your child have had a lovely, relaxing half-term break. In exciting news, alongside our usual adults, Class 3 will have extra support this half term from Mr Jasonson.

Literacy: In Literacy, we will be studying The Iron Man by Ted Hughes. We will first focus on writing to inform in the form of a newspaper article. We will then move on to writing to entertain in the form of a narrative.

Maths: In maths we will continue with multiplication and division, before moving on to length and perimeter and fractions. After this we will shift our focus to mass and capacity.

Science: Our topic is 'Earth rocks.' Students will test, compare and group rocks. They will study their properties and ways to record and present investigation results.

RE: We will return to Christianity, paying particular attention to Easter and its significance to Christians. We will continue to ask big questions and challenge ourselves to uncover links between religions.

History: We will continue to learn about prehistory, looking at the Bronze and Iron Ages. Our learning will include how people lived during these periods, hillforts and the Bell Beaker people.

DT: In DT, our unit is called 'Mechanical Systems: Pneumatic Toys.' Throughout these lessons, students will design and create toys operated by air.

Music: This half term Class 3 will be continue to participate in musicianship with PMF (Pimlico Music Foundation).

PSHE: PSHE will be varied, ranging from health, internet safety and respect for ourselves and others.

PE: PE will take place on Wednesday mornings with support from Chelsea FC in the school grounds. Please send your child to school in their PE kit each Wednesday and ensure they have their uniform with them to change into after the lesson. Class 3 will continue swimming lessons every Monday afternoon starting on Monday 24th February.

Spanish: We will learn about fruits as well as adding to our knowledge of short phrases.

Computing: Computing will comprise of learning how to send and receive emails as well as branching databases.
