### 1. The School will

- (a) Ensure a Christian ethos in the school and expects that all pupils will attend services in Church as required.
- (b) Work with parents in the best interests of the child
- (c) Provide a balanced curriculum and encourage children to be Excellent and do their best at all times.
- (d) Ensure that all work set will be well prepared and appropriate to each child.
- (e) Encourage children to behave courteously at all times towards all members of our community, ensuring bullying of any nature is not tolerated and quickly addressed
- (f) Provide a safe and caring environment and encourage children to show respect for the school and equipment.
- (g) Contact parents should the child bump their head or have a significant medical emergency
- (h) Make sure that all children and their families are treated with respect, sensitivity and compassion.
- (i) Inform parents about what the teachers plan to teach the children.
- (j) Inform parents of children's progress at parent's meetings and send home an annual report.
- (k) Inform parents about school activities through regular newsletters, letters home and the daily notice board.
- (l) Inform parents if there is a problem with attendance, punctuality or equipment.
- (m) Contact parents as soon as the school becomes concerned about a child's behaviour or standard of work.
- (n) Set, promptly mark and monitor homework.
- (o) Try to be open and welcoming and offer opportunities for parents to become involved in the daily life of the school.
- (p) Listen and offer a calm response to parental queries.
- (q) Ensure that safeguarding systems are rigorous.
- (r) Ensure that all statutory obligations are met.

## 2. The Family will:

- (a) Work together with staff in the best interests of the pupils
- (b) Make sure that their child attends school every day and on time and telephone or provide a written note or explanation if absent on the first day by 9.30am.
- (c) Make sure the child arrives to school on time (9.00am), dressed in correct uniform, equipped for the day and is collected promptly after school, (3.30pm) or promptly when an after school club or after school care finishes
- (d) Appreciate that this is a Christian school and support the Christian ethos of St Gabriel's
- (e) Treat all members of the school community with respect – setting a good example with speech and behaviour
- (f) Approach all members of staff calmly whenever a difficulty arises, seeking a peaceful resolution to all issues.
- (g) Work with the school to address and support their child with behavioural concerns.
- (h) Approach a member of the teaching staff (and no one else) if there are any behavioural problems with their own or other children.
- (i) Let the school know about any concerns, problems or circumstances that might affect their child's work, behaviour or ability to learn effectively.
- (j) Actively support the school's policies.
- (k) Daily make every effort to ensure that their child has the correct uniform.
- (l) Notify the school if their child cannot attend school, or will be arriving or picked up late.
- (m) If attendance or punctuality problems develop, parents are expected to work actively with school staff and the Early Help Team to solve them.
- (n) Attempt to arrange doctor, dentist and other similar appointments outside school hours. In extreme circumstances consult with the school beforehand.
- (o) Ensure all holidays are taken outside term time and understand that if they do so that it will be unauthorised and may be issued with a fine from the Local Authority.
- (p) Support their child with homework and other opportunities for home learning.
- (q) Do their best to attend parent's evenings and other school events when their child is involved.
