Dear parents and carers,
I hope you have had a lovely break. This term we will be delving into lots of exciting new learning.

Literacy: We will be studying the Roman myth of Romulus and Remus. We will first focus on writing to entertain with a myth, before moving on to writing to inform with a newspaper report.

Maths: We will continue to learn about mass and capacity before building on our knowledge of fractions. After this, we will then study money.

RE: We will study Buddhism and explore what Buddha taught his followers about life. We will continue to ask big questions and challenge ourselves to uncover links between religions.

Geography: We will learn about Africa, including locating countries, identifying biomes and studying the main climate zones.

Art: In Art, we will be studying and creating 3D sculptures with a focus on abstract space and shape.

Music: We will participate in musicianship with PMF (Pimlico Music Foundation). We will be singing a wide range of songs of varying style with pitch and expression.

PSHE: PSHE will encompass healthy diets, oral hygiene, the importance of taking medicines correctly and using household products safely.

Spanish: We will be studying ice-creams, with a particular focus on flavours.

Computing: Computing will comprise of branching databases, simulations and graphs.

PE: This half term we are delighted to have Lord's Cricket running sessions in school. This will take place on Wednesdays in the school grounds. Please ensure your child wears their school PE kit to school each Wednesday. We will continue swimming lessons every Monday afternoon.

Science: Our topic is 'Food and our bodies.' We will study human and animal skeletons, paying particular attention to their function. We'll also look at joints and muscles, as well as exploring both human and animal diets.

Homework: Key Stage Two children will continue Genius work alongside their spellings, reading and times tables.
