Would you like advice from an Educational Psychologist?

On **Wednesday, 5th March**, parents have the opportunity to book a **20-minute appointment** with the school's Educational Psychologist between **9:00 and 11:00 am**. This is a great chance to discuss any questions or concerns you may have about your child's learning, development, or well-being. To secure a time, please contact the school office as soon as possible.

Attendance

Please avoid booking any leave during term time. If a holiday/visit abroad could have been made during a school holiday, an absence will not be authorised. As many of our families have relatives abroad, we understand that it is not always easy to see family just in holiday time, and the price of flights can be so much more expensive during school holiday time. Whilst we are very sympathetic to this, the price of travel is not an acceptable reason and an absence will not be authorised. 10 unauthorised sessions (or 5 days) during a 10 week period will result in a penalty notice referral and will

likely result in a fine. If a fine is not paid it is doubled. If a fine remains unpaid, it can result in prosecution and a court appearance. These are the rules that the government put in place at the beginning of this academic year, therefore schools are under a statutory obligation to follow this guidance.

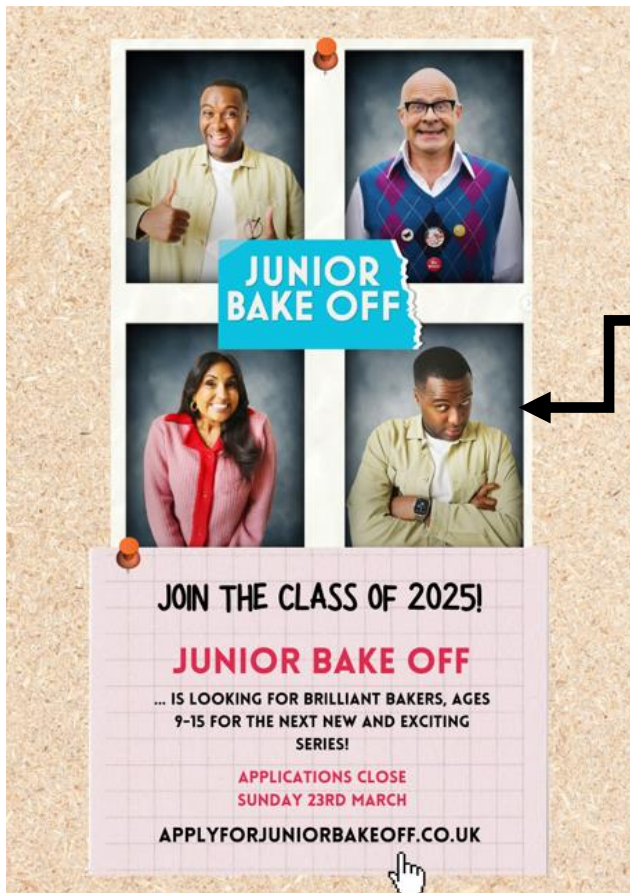
