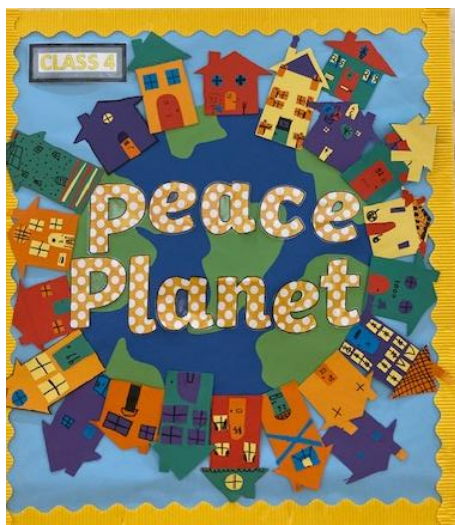

Our new value for the term

Last week, each class looked at the bible reference for this term's value of peace: 'Let the PEACE of Christ rule in your hearts, since as members of one body you were called to peace.' (Colossians 3 verse 15). They discussed what the verse meant, what peace means to them and the importance of how we treat each other, as being a part of us achieving peace. In Family assembly, it was lovely to then hear what each class had been talking about. Children also shared art work



inspired by different stories they had read, or different aspects of what peace can mean. Reception shared some lovely pictures of elephants, having read 'Five Minutes Peace' together and Year 1 shared the blanket they had designed for the bears in 'Peace at Last'. Classes also looked at how we can create peace in school, in the way we treat each other and how we can work for peace in our communities and our world.

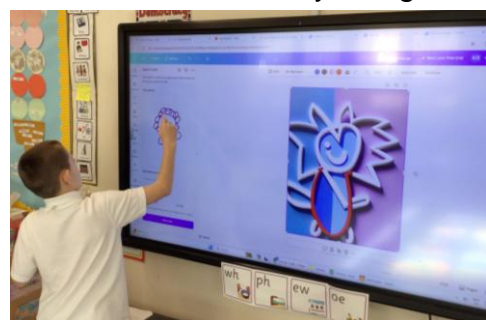
